



HOMEMADE STAIN REMOVER SPRAY

MAKES TWO OUNCES

MATERIALS

3/4 cup water

1/4 cup unscented liquid castile soap (we use Dr. Bronner's Baby Soap for almost everything in our house)

1/4 cup liquid vegetable glycerin

10 drops lemon essential oil

Glass spray bottle

Printable label PDF

Label sheet, printer and scissors

DIRECTIONS

Mix together the water, castile soap, vegetable glycerin and essential oil. Pour into a glass spray bottle. The lemon essential oil tends to eat away at plastic, so try to store in glass if possible. Cut out your preferred label and stick to the bottle.

To use, spray liberally on the stain, rub in a bit with your fingers and let sit or soak before washing. If it's a really tough stain, try letting it soak overnight (and maybe applying the spray a few times).

HOW IT WORKS

The castile soap is the superstar of this recipe—it's a strong soap that eats away at stains. The vegetable glycerin thickens the mixture and helps the soap to "stick" to the stain. And lemon is a natural anti-bacterial and an all-natural stain fighter—it breaks down oils and other tough-to-fight stains.
